



## REVERSE CIRCULATION DRILLING TO COMMENCE AT DIABLO GOLD PROSPECT

Barra Resources Limited (ASX Code: BAR) wishes to advise that reverse circulation (RC) drilling is set to commence at its Phillips Find Gold Project, located 50 kilometres north-northwest of Coolgardie, Western Australia.

The RC drilling, due to commence 23 September 2009, is the Company's first phase infill drilling program designed to follow-up an outstanding Rotary Air-Blast (RAB) intersection at its Diablo prospect (see ASX Announcement released 14 August 2009), where rotary air-blast (RAB) drillhole PFRB051 intersected: **14.0 metres grading 5.75 grams per tonnes gold from 44 metres depth (including 7.0 metres grading 10.84 grams per tonne gold).**

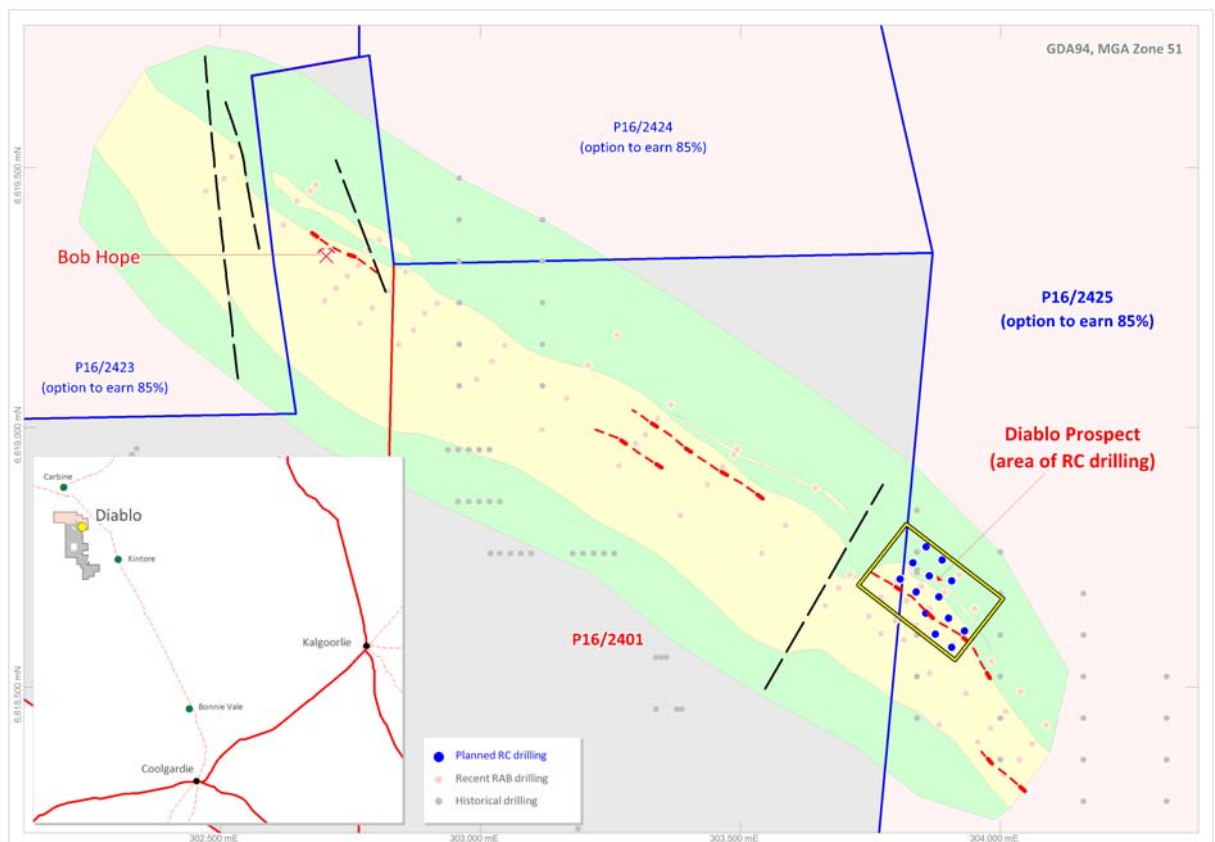


Figure 1: Location area of RC drilling at the Diablo.

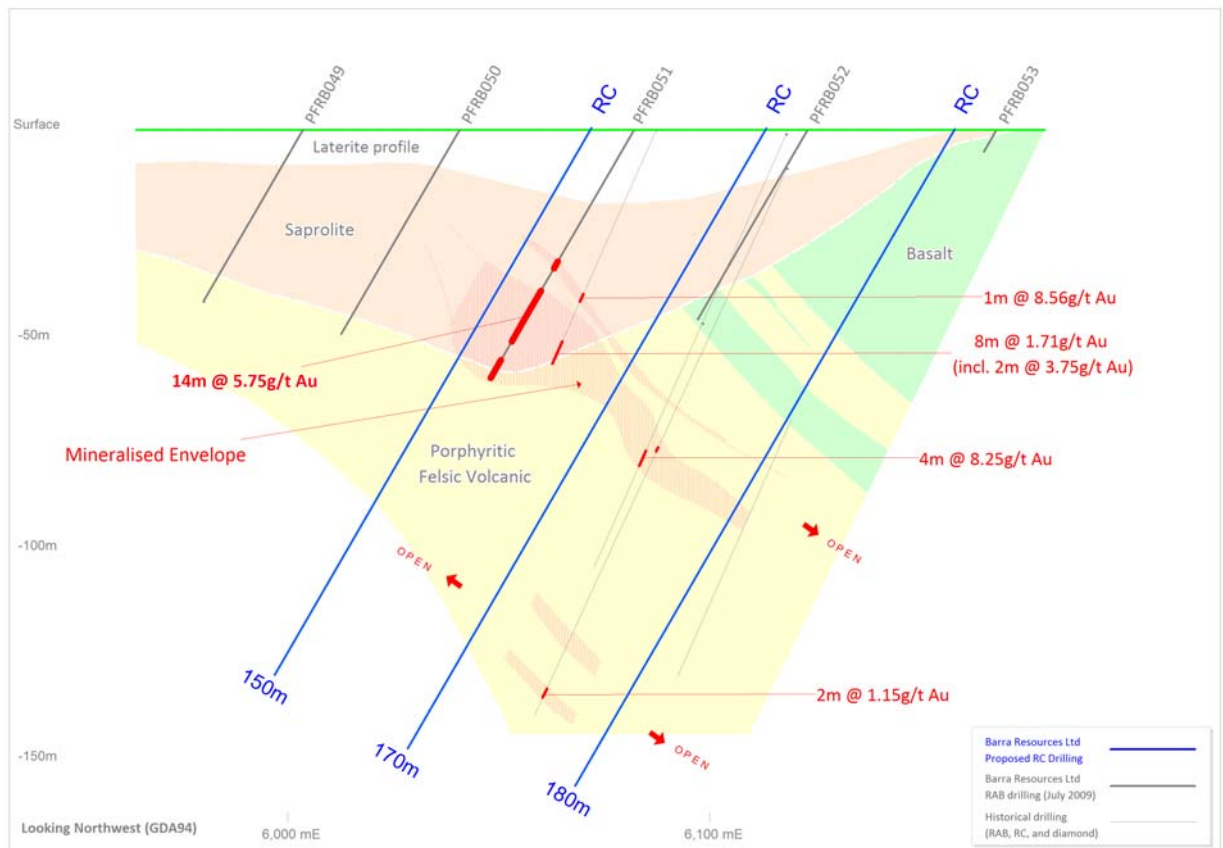


Figure 2: Schematic cross-section through Diablo showing planned RC drilling in relation to RAB drill hole PFRB051.

An initial thirteen RC drill holes (approximately 2,000 metres) have been designed to test the extent of the shallow high-grade gold mineralisation in the oxide zone to the north and south of PFRB051 over a distance of 200 metres. The drilling will also test down-dip to a vertical depth of 150 metres to test the potential of primary gold mineralisation intersected in historical drilling (Figures 1 and 2).
